

In an effort to protect each child's health and safety, Ruach Day Camp requires that every child be immunized in accordance with Public Health 2164 and the age appropriate dosages as set forth by the Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices. Accordingly, as a condition of attendance, an immunization record must be submitted for each camper with proof of immunization against the following communicable diseases: polio, mumps, measles, diphtheria, rubella, varicella, Haemophilus influenza type b (Hib), pertussis, tetanus, pneumococcal disease, and hepatitis B. It is our policy that all campers be fully immunized and the Camp is not mandated under the Law to consider and/or accept a request for a religious or medical exemption.
